The Muslim Interscholastic Tournament (MIST) is a fun. educational, interactive program of competitions and workshops geared towards bringing high school students together from around the nation to develop leadership, communication, and various creative skills while gaining a deeper understanding of Islam and Muslims, MIST consists of annual regional tournaments that take place in Philadelphia and 18 other regions across the United States and Canada. Student winners from each regional tournament qualify to compete at the annual national tournament, held each summer, MIST currently features 35 different competitions covering the arts, sciences, and humanities.



MIST Philly was founded in 2009, and currently serves students from in and around the Greater Philadelphia Area, as well as central Pennsylvania and Delaware. Our students come from all ethnic, religious, and socioeconomic backgrounds. With only a few dozen students in 2009, our 2019 tournament hosted over 500 combined attendees, consisting of over 300 competitors, as well as guests, invited judges and speakers, and an organizing team of over 70 people. MIST Philly has become one of the hallmark events on the Muslim community calendar here in Philadelphia.

WHAT HAPPENS AT MIST?

During MIST weekend, students compete in solo and group competitions under the guidance of qualified professionals that are invited to judge. Some categories include Knowledge & Qur'an, Arts, Writing & Oratory (includes spoken word, oratory, and essay competitions), Bracket competitions (includes Quiz Bowl and Debate), Group Projects (includes Business Venture, Science Fair and Humanitarian Service), and Sports (Basketball and Soccer).

Parallel to the competitions are workshops designed to address critical issues and topics concerning high school students, as well as opportunities to network with their peers and explore their passions.






